Abstract submission terms and conditions

Conference abstracts will be published by BMJ Publishing Group Limited (BMJ) in a special online supplement of the journal BMJ Supportive & Palliative Care (BMJ SPC). By submitting your abstract (the work) **you agree** that, if selected for the Conference, **you give BMJ an exclusive licence for its publication** in BMJ SPC in compliance with the terms of BMJ Publishing Group's standard licence for publication of conference abstracts which is [here](#). **It is very important that you read and agree to the terms of the licence.**

By agreeing to comply with the [licence](#) and the Abstract submission terms and conditions listed here below, you are confirming that everyone named as an Author has had an active role in the work and, where appropriate, ethics approval has been obtained. You are also confirming:

1. that you have permission to provide email addresses of any co-author(s)
2. that the abstract does not contain anything libellous, defamatory, fraudulent or otherwise unlawful
3. that the abstract you are submitting has not been, and if accepted will not be, **presented** or **published** elsewhere
4. that all those named as an Author agree to this use of their work and that the abstract does not infringe any third party's copyright. Note that if copyright is held by any employer of a named Author, you must have that employer's prior written authority to the grant of the licence to BMJ SPC.
5. that given the BMJ's exclusive licence, if accepted your own right (and any co-author's right) to use the abstract is restricted as set out under "Author's Rights" in the BMJ's standard licence for publication of conference abstracts
6. that if applicable, you will advise us at the time of submission of any funding sources which are relevant for the purposes of the "Open Access" provisions of the BMJ's standard licence for publication of conference abstracts.
7. that all named Authors comply with BMJ's policy on AI (artificial intelligence) use available at the following URL:

In support of the fair and objective review of abstracts, your submission should not include any detail in the title or the main body of the abstract which identifies particular organisations or individuals.
